Biography

Drosophila Christos Consoulas received B.Sc. in Biology from the Department of Biology, Aristotelian University of Thessaloniki and his Ph.D. from the same Department. Then, for a period of 10 years, he moved to the Arizona Research Laboratories-Division of Neurobiology where he worked as a researcher in the remodeling of the motor system during postembryonic development.
